Official City Council Minutes City of Wood River, Nebraska Regular Meeting January 3, 2023

Pursuant to due call and notice thereof, a Regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Wood River, Nebraska was conducted in the Council Chambers of City Hall, 108 W. 10th St, on December 28, 2022. Notice of the time and place of the meeting was given in advance thereof by publicized notice on January 3, 2022 in the Clipper and the Grand Island Independent. An agenda for the meeting, was kept continuously current, and was made available for public inspection on the City's website (woodriverne.com).

Mayor Greg Cramer called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Council Present: Nielsen, Rotter Rodriguez, Rennau, and Thompson. Vacancy in Ward 1.

City Officials Present: Ashley Manning, City Clerk; Drew Graham, City Attorney.

Public Present: Alicia Jonak

The Mayor led the Council Members and audience in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Cramer advised the public body of the Open Meetings Act that is posted in the meeting room and entry hall.

Public Comment(s): None.

Items on the consent agenda for approval were: December 20, 2022, Regular Meeting Minutes.

Nielsen made the motion to approve items on the consent agenda. Motion seconded by Thompson. Motion carried. 5/0.

Council discussed the possibility of allowing chickens within City Limits. City Attorney Drew Graham was present to answer questions regarding registration processes and advise on best practices for complaints and compliance. A draft ordinance was presented to Council that includes rules and regulations. Alicia Jonak attended in support of allowing chickens. James Thompson brought up the possible noise complaints that will occur if neighbors of those with chickens have dogs. There are restrictions on placement of the coop from neighboring property lines. Rotter motioned to move forward and introduce the Ordinance at the next City Council meeting. Motion seconded by Rodriguez. Motion carried 4/1 – Thompson voting no.

Employee handbook discussion will occur at a future meeting.

The City received one janitorial bid. Bid was received from Rodriguez Sisters for a fee of \$500.00 per month, regular weekly cleaning. Rotter motioned to approve the bid from Rodriguez Sisters for a set fee of \$500.00 per month for cleaning of the Community Center and City Hall. Motion seconded by Nielsen. Motion carried 4/0 - Rodriguez abstained.

Nielsen motioned to approve payment to Felsburg Holt & Ullevig (Invoice 35749) in the amount of \$29,743.75 for Advance Assistance project work. Motion seconded by Rennau. Motion carried 5/0.

Mayor Cramer appointed a committee for selecting the architect engineer for the senior center project: Eric Nielsen, Greg Cramer, Kila Turek, Heather Rotter, Mike Rennau. **Nielsen** motioned to approve the committee as appointed by Mayor Cramer. Motion seconded by **Rotter**. Motion carried 5/0.

Rotter motioned to approve Mayor Cramer signing a letter of notice to apply for the Civic Community Center Financing Fund program for the Library space of the Legacy Station in the amount of \$562,000.00 using capital proceeds of the Library fund as the matching grant monies and having Sara Arnett, Wood River Vision 2020 Board Member as the local contact. Motion seconded by Rennau. Motion carried 5/0.

Department Remarks:

None.

Council Remarks:

Thompson: Asked about ATV/UTV registration requirements if using vehicle to move snow. Council indicated that if vehicle has a blade on it and is actively moving snow, no registration is needed. Registration is required for vehicles to be out driving on the City Streets.

Nielsen: Legacy Station needs to be 100% supported by Council for some grant applications, this means that each Council member needs to donate money to the project.

None.

As there was no further business to come before this session of the Council, Council member **Nielsen** made the motion to adjourn at 7:41 p.m. Motion seconded by **Thompson**.

ORDINANCE NO. 580

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 6 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF WOOD RIVER, NEBRASKA, TO ADOPT A NEW SECTION 6-214 OF THE CODE TO ALLOW THE KEEPING OF BACKYARD CHICKENS SUBJECT TO CERTAIN RESTRICTIONS; REPEALING ALL OTHER ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT WITH THIS ORDINANCE; APPROVING PUBLICATION IN PAMPHLET FORM; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOOD RIVER, HALL COUNTY, NEBRASKA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. ADOPTION OF NEW SECTION 6-214:

That a new Chapter 6, Article 214 of the Municipal Code of Wood River, Nebraska, be adopted to provide as follows:

Sec. 6-214. – KEEPING OF BACKYARD CHICKENS

The keeping of hens and hen bantams in residential districts on property consisting of a single-family dwelling is allowed, subject to the following:

- A. Any person who keeps hens or bantams in the City of Wood River shall obtain a license from the City prior to acquiring the hens or bantams. Application shall be made to City Hall, and the fee for the license shall be ten dollars (\$10.00).
- B. Licenses are valid for the calendar year and shall expire and become invalid on December 31st at the end of the calendar year after the date of issuance; prorating the fee is not allowed. A person who wishes to continue keeping hens or hen bantams shall have obtained a new license on or before January 1st. Application for a new license shall be pursuant to the administrative procedures and requirements that are applicable at the time the person applies for a new license.
- C. A person who keeps or houses hens or bantams on his or her property shall comply with all of the following requirements:

- 1. No more than four (4) hens and/or hen bantams may be kept on any one zoning lot. Hereinafter "hens" and "hen bantams" will be referenced collectively as "chickens".
- 2. The principal use of the property shall be a single-family dwelling, and the license applicant shall be the owner of the property.
- 3. No person shall keep any rooster.
- 4. No person shall slaughter any chickens.
- 5. The chickens shall be provided with a covered fenced enclosure or coop (hereinafter, "chicken enclosure") and must be kept in the chicken enclosure at all times. Such chicken enclosure shall contain at least four (4) square feet of floor area per chicken, and the chicken enclosure shall provide at least ten (10) square feet of open area per chicken; no chicken enclosure shall exceed one hundred twenty (120) square feet of floor area or exceed seven (7) feet in height.
- 6. A person shall not keep chickens in any location on the property other than in the chicken enclosure in the rear yard. For purposes of this section "rear yard" means that portion of a lot enclosed by the property's rear lot line and the side lot lines to the points where the side lot lines intersect with an imaginary line established by the rear of the dwelling and extending to the side lot lines.
- 7. No chicken enclosure shall be located closer than ten (10) feet to any property line of an adjacent property.
- 8. No chicken enclosure shall be located closer than forty (40) feet to any residential structure on another person's property.
- 9. All chicken enclosures shall be constructed or repaired to prevent rats, mice, or other rodents from being harbored underneath, within, or within the walls of the enclosure.
- 10. All feed and other items associated with the keeping of chickens that are likely to attract or to become infested with or infected by rats, mice, or other rodents shall be protected so as to prevent rats, mice,

or other rodents from gaining access to or coming into contact with the food and other associated items.

- 11. Eggs produced by licensed chickens may be sold by the license holder, subject to compliance with the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Wood River, Nebraska, Section 11-301 Home occupations and home-based businesses.
- 12.A person who has been issued a license freely and voluntarily consents to a search and examination of the chicken enclosure in his/her rear yard upon demand by any Police Officer or Code Enforcement Officer.

If any of the above requirements are not complied with, the City may revoke any license granted under this section and/or initiate prosecution of the license holder and/or any other person violating the Code. Violations are misdemeanors punishable by Sec. 6-401 of this Code.

SECTION 3. REPEAL:

That all ordinances or portions of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. PUBLICATION AND EFFECTIVE DATE:

This ordinance is adopted and approved for publishing in pamphlet form, and shall be in full force and effect from and after 15 days after its passage, approval, and publication or posting as provided by law. The provisions of this Ordinance shall become and be made part of the Municipal Code of the City of Wood River, Nebraska and sections of this Ordinance may be renumbered to accomplish such intention.
