#### Official City Council Minutes City of Wood River, Nebraska Regular Meeting February 21, 2023

Pursuant to due call and notice thereof, a Regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Wood River, Nebraska was conducted in the Council Chambers of City Hall, 108 W. 10th St, on February 21, 2023. Notice of the time and place of the meeting was given in advance thereof by publicized notice on February 15, 2023 in the Clipper and the Grand Island Independent. An agenda for the meeting, was kept continuously current, and was made available for public inspection on the City's website (woodriverne.com).

Mayor Greg Cramer called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Council Present: Nielsen, Rennau, Rodriguez, and Thompson. Rotter absent.

City Officials Present: Ashley Manning, City Clerk; Christina Wemhoff, Treasurer; Brent Gascho, Utilities Superintendent

Public Present: Sara Arnett; Neal Niedfelt; Same Reinke

The Mayor led the Council Members and audience in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Cramer advised the public body of the Open Meetings Act that is posted in the meeting room and entry hall.

Items on the consent agenda for approval were: January 17, 2023 and February 7, 2023, Regular Meeting Minutes. Disbursements reviewed this month by: Thompson & Rennau Disbursements totaling: \$22,848.50

Disbursements totaling: \$22,848.5 Checks not on list: \$86,730.21 Sales Tax Paid: \$7,196.66

Nielsen made the motion to approve items on the consent agenda as presented. Motion seconded by Rennau. Motion carried 4/0. Rotter absent.

Sara Arnett was present to explain the RBDG revolving loan grant, asking the City to apply for the grant. The maximum amount that can be applied for is \$99,900. Funding would be used as a revolving loan to new and expanding businesses in town as well as training. A committee would oversee the application processes and recommend applicants and interest rates to Council for final approval. Nielsen motioned to approve moving forward with the City applying for the Rural Business Development Grant. Motion seconded by Rodriguez. Motion carried 4/0. Rotter absent.

Nielsen motioned to introduce Resolution 2023-186 authorizing application for rural business development grant in the amount of \$99,900. Motion seconded by Rennau. Motion carried 4/0. Rotter absent.

Sam Reinke and Neal Niedfelt were present to summarize the SPPD annual report stating that wholesale rates are increasing about 7/10 and the PCA incentive has decreased by about \$40,000. They also spoke of the many rebate/incentive programs that are offered through SPPD that all of Wood River's electric customers are able to apply for.

Ashley Manning explained that the City's fire alarm panel requires 2 land lines. When the City switched to internet based phone service, one of the land lines connected to the panel was disconnected. Nebraska Safety and Fire came out to provide a quote to install IP/Cell Communicator so that the City wouldn't need to reconnect an additional landline. Rodriguez motioned to approve the quote from Nebraska Safety and Fire in the amount of \$1,935.00 for installation of IP/Cell Communicator. Motion seconded by Nielsen. Motion carried 4/0. Rotter absent.

Council discussed the proposed employee handbook. Some changes were proposed by Council regarding sick time, part time holiday pay, and the options regarding paying out unused time carned vs accrued. The committee will meet on Monday to make the changes and present an updated version at the next council meeting.

Mayor Cramer stated that he received two letters of interest for the vacant Ward 1 Council seat, term ending 2024. After some discussion, Rennau motioned to approve appointing Dakota Klingsporn to the vacant Ward 1 seat. Motion seconded by Thompson. Motion carried 4/0. Rotter absent.

Nielsen motioned to approve reimbursement for façade improvements on WRDTR-03 in the amount of \$12,814.12. Motion seconded by Thompson. Motion carried 4/0. Rotter absent.

Rennau motioned to approve draw request #20 in the amount of \$12,814.12 for project #19-DTR-108. Motion seconded by **Thompson**. Motion carried 4/0. **Rotter** absent.

Rodriguez motioned to approve payment to CDS Inspections (Invoice OOR-A41) for housing management services in the amount of \$1,300.00. Motion seconded by Thompson. Motion carried 4/0. Rotter absent.

Thompson motioned to approve payment to SCEDD (Invoice 1511) for grant administration in the amount of \$3,200.00. Motion seconded by Rennau. Motion carried 4/0. Rotter absent.

Thompson motioned to approve draw request #26 in the amount of \$4,500.00 for project #19-TFDR-34089. Motion seconded by Rodriguez. Motion carried 4/0. Rotter absent.

Nielsen motioned to approve the quotes received from ABC Seamless for the pool house, pump house, and ball field announcers stand damages sustained during the summer hail storm in the total amount of \$181,280.00. Motion seconded by Rennau. Motion carried 4/0. Rotter absent.

Christina Wemhoff summarized the Treasurer's Report for the month of January 2023.

Thompson: Ball park lights – asked Brent if he had contacted Ensley Electric yet, he has not. Need to put together a committee to go over the City's equipment and get a list of what equipment needs replaced/repaired.

# Dear Greg:

This report for the above referenced project describes progress made in the past period, any deliverables submitted, the status of the budget and schedule, and estimates progress to be made in the upcoming period. To help with the quarterly reporting and grant reimbursement requests, I am including a budget summary for each grant task, along with project management cost summary and detail as requested by NEMA. Also included is Invoice No. 36400 in the amount of \$77,882.50 with a total billed-to-date amount of \$305,011.81 which represents approximately 55% of the original contract amount.

### **Progress This Period**

Progress on the drainage improvement plans for all locations continued this period. Both the FHU design and the W Design Associates plan components progressed to the point of a submittal to you. This included preliminary structural plans for the box culverts within US Hwy. 30 right-of-way. We worked on developing right-of-way details to determine where property rights may need to be acquired and coordinating on utilities.

The Environmental team did a critical habitat and Threatened/Endangered species review and coordinated with NE Game and Parks for that evaluation. They completed the Hazardous materials and wetland delineation reports. The also finished the Environmental Justice documentation. We finalized drafts for the required public involvement material and a public involvement plan, including the fact sheet and letter to stakeholders.

Work also continued on drafting the Hazardous Mitigation Grant application.

Project management tasks included coordination with Ashley and NEMA on grant management, and meeting with NEMA for a monthly progress report.

# Deliverables This Pay Period

Preliminary plans were sent to the City on 1/26/2023.

#### Meetings

Our coordination meetings with W Design and Associates have moved to biweekly or as needed until further development is indicated. I met with the NEMA team on January 19, 2023, for a monthly coordination and progress check in meeting.

## Anticipated Progress in the Next Period

In the next period I anticipate we will update hydraulic data based on the design, work on defining wetland impacts and right-of-way status. We will be working on computing project quantities to get an estimate for the benefit cost analysis. I will be reaching out to NDOT to coordinate work with them as well. We would like to visit with you to gain feedback on the plans and public involvement materials as well.

# **Budget and Schedule Status**

As noted above, at the end of this period we are 55% through the budget for the work on the Advance Assistance (Drainage Improvements) project. I will continue to work with Ashley to provide assistance on the submittal documentation for reimbursement from NEMA.
