### Official City Council Minutes City of Wood River, Nebraska Regular Meeting October 3, 2023

Pursuant to due call and notice thereof, a Regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Wood River, Nebraska was conducted in the Council Chambers of City Hall, 108 W. 10<sup>th</sup> St, on October 3, 2023. Notice of the time and place of the meeting was given in advance thereof by publicized notice on September 27, 2023 in the Clipper and the Grand Island Independent. An agenda for the meeting, was kept continuously current, and was made available for public inspection on the City's website (woodriverne.com).

Mayor Greg Cramer called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Council Present: Nielsen, Rotter, Rennau, Thompson.

City Officials Present: Brent Gascho, Utilities Superintendent; Ashley Manning, City Clerk; Drew Graham,

City Attorney, Christina Wemhoff, Treasurer.

Public Present: Chad Shuda, Veronica Kaufman, Deputy J. Jones.

The Mayor led the Council Members and audience in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Cramer advised the public body of the Open Meetings Act that is posted in the meeting room and entry hall.

Nielsen made the motion to approve items on the consent agenda. Motion seconded by Rotter. Motion carried. 4/0. Rodriguez and Klingsporn absent.

Deputy J. Jones presented the Sheriff's Report for the month of September 2023.

Rennau motioned to approve requesting bids for asbestos abatement at the Legacy Station Building. Motion seconded by Rotter. Motion carried 4/0. Rodriguez and Klingsporn absent.

Mayor Cramer discussed the proposed compost fee ordinance. Council discussed increasing the residential rate to \$30 per year and establishing a commercial daily fee of \$100. Updated ordinance will be brought to the next meeting for further discussion/approval.

Mayor Cramer is working with Corey Brodersen at JEO to put together a scope of work agreement for the Senior Center architectural services.

Rotter motioned to approve advertising for bids for excess property located at the depot – firewood, shingles, scrap iron. Motion seconded by Nielsen. Motion carried 4/0. Rodriguez and Klingsporn absent.

Nielsen motioned to approve Lindsey Nielsen as a Fire Department member. Motion seconded by Rotter. Motion carried 4/0. Rodriguez and Klingsporn absent.

Brent Gascho updated Council on the Dodd Street Sewer project. Steve Wolford got the sewer grinder ordered. They plan to put a new manhole somewhere between Dodd and Cottonwood along with the new line for easier maintenance and will leave the existing manhole to the west.

Brent Gascho summarized the bid received from Midlands Contracting for the Dodd Street Sewer project. There will be a change order in the future to add tapping into residential sewer connections – Neil Wolford estimates 4 connections Rotter motioned to approve bid received from Midlands Contracting (6" option) in the amount of \$59,197.00 for the Dodd Street Sewer project.. Motion seconded by Rennau. Motion carried 4/0. Rodriguez and Klingsporn absent.

Nielsen motioned to approve sending Brent and Zane to the Nebraska Mosquito and Vector Control meetin g on October 5 and 6 in Kearney for a total amount of \$100.00. Motion seconded by Rotter, Motion carried 4/0. Rodriguez and Klingsporn absent.

Rotter motioned to approve payment to JEO (Invoice 144685) in the amount of \$2,037.00 for work completed on Electric GIS project. Motion seconded by Rennau. Motion carried 4/0. Rodriguez and Klingsporn absent.

Rennau motioned to approve payment to Felsburg Holt Ullevig (Invoice 38642) in the amount of \$9,470.60 for Advance Assistance project work. Motion seconded by Thompson. Motion carried 4/0. Rodriguez and Klingsporn absent.

Veronica Kaufman explained to Council that after advertising for the opening on the Library Board in August, two letters of interest were received. The board met and approved Sarah Haahr. Rennau motioned to approve Sarah Haahr filling the open Library Board seat. Motion seconded by Nielsen. Motion carried 4/0. Rodriguez and Klingsporn absent.

Rotter motioned to approve annual review for Ana Sanchez moving her to a step 3 for an hourly rate of \$12.55 as of her date of hire anniversary. Motion seconded by Rennau. Motion carried 4/0. Rodriguez and Klingsporn absent.

Mayor Cramer discussed working hours, break periods, punctuality. He has noticed issues with some City employees taking excessively long breaks, arriving late to work, etc.

### Department Remarks:

Gascho: (1) IES is planning to start work this fall – will begin with trenching and electrical while they wait for supplies to arrive. (2) Hydrant flushing is done, all but one hydrant was flushed. Three were repaired and all got oil. Chad Shuda added that 5 hydrants need replaced – Brent to get prices. Will take a line stop to replace a few of those 5. (3) Marty has been applying sludge, it's going well. (4) Nebraska Generator is here, brought in a backup generator to handle the power load while the generator is being switched out – will be back in a few weeks to make the switch. (5) Received the pot hole machine, waiting for additional nozzle to arrive as wrong one was sent with the machine. There was a water leak the MacQueen fixed on site.

Veronica Kaufman: Asked about her mom still working for the library part time. When she was hired she was labeled as a temp-part time worker. Asked Drew if she could stay on longer term. Drew answered yes, the City may want to re-class her actual employment status.

Shuda: Asked about vehicles, RVs, trailers, etc. and the updates to the parking ordinance. Asked if there was anything the City could do to enforce. Cramer still working on a solution.

Wemhoff: Neil Wolford said that culverts are in – all need scooped out and 200' of pipe cleaned out. They are 18" pipes and are currently over half full of dirt.

**Graham:** Serves on Serve Nebraska and will be attending the Step Forward awards in Lincoln on Friday where Vision 2020 will be receiving an award.

### Council Remarks:

Nielsen: (1) Thanked Brent for removing the trash from Roland Lemburg's yard. (2) Spoke with Todd King, members of council on the Fire Board and the Rural Fire Department will meet this winter.

# RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONDITIONAL USE OF REAL ESTATE LOCATED AT 404 E 13<sup>TH</sup> ST, WOOD RIVER VILLAGE BRETT & JOHNSON'S ADDITION LOTS 9 & 10 BLOCK 4, HALL COUNTY, NEBRASKA.

WHEREAS, Michael Carlson, hereinafter referred to Applicant, is the owner of real estate located at 404 E 13<sup>th</sup> St., Wood River, Nebraska. A location within the municipal boundaries of the City of Wood River, Nebraska and more particularly described as:

Wood River Village Brett & Johnson's Addition Lots 9 & 10 Block 4, Hall County, Nebraska, hereinafter referred to as the premises; and

WHEREAS, the Applicant has made a written application to use the premises for establishing and operating a gunsmithing business; and

WHEREAS, the proposed use in a district zoned R-6 Medium Density Residential is a permitted conditional use pursuant to 5.09.03 of the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Wood River, Nebraska as amended; and

WHEREAS, on October 17, 2023, a public hearing on said application was held by the Wood River City Council upon due and proper notice of said hearing; and

WHEREAS, public comment was invited at the public hearing before the City Council regarding the application for conditional use.

NOWBE IT RESOLVED THE CITY AND THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF WOOD RIVER, HALL COUNTY, NEBRASKA HEREBY FIND AS FOLLOWS:

- The establishment, maintenance or operation of the conditional use will not be detrimental to or endanger the public health, safety, moral, comfort or general welfare of the community.
- 2. That the conditional use will not be injurious to the use and enjoyment of other property in the immediate vicinity for the purpose already permitted nor substantially diminish or impair property values within the neighborhood.
- 3. That the establishment of the conditional use will not impede the normal and orderly development of the surrounding property for uses permitted in the District.
- 4. That adequate utilities, access roads, drainage and or necessary facilities have been or being provided.
- 5. That adequate measures have been or will be taken to provide ingress and

- egress so designed as to minimize traffic congestion in the public streets.
- 6. The use shall not include noise which is objectionable due to volume Frequency or beat unless muffled or otherwise controlled.
- 7. The use shall not involve any pollution of the air by fly ash, dust, vapors or other substance which is harmful to health, animals, vegetation or other property or which can cause soiling discomfort or irritation.
- 8. The use shall not involve any malodorous gas or matter which is discernable on any adjoining lot or property.
- 9. The use shall not involve any direct or reflected glare which is visible from any adjoining property or from any public street, road or highway.
- 10. The use shall not involve any activity substantially increasing the movement of traffic on public streets unless procedures are instituted to limited traffic hazards and congestion.
- 11. The use shall not involve any activities substantially increasing the burden on any public utilities or facilities unless provisions are made for any necessary adjustments.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT Applicant's application for conditional use of the premises for establishing and operating a gunsmithing business should be and is hereby granted subject to the conditions, restrictions and limitations contained herein:

- 1. The premises shall be used solely for establishing and operating a gunsmithing business and such other
  - "permitted uses" within the R-6 Medium Density Residential district.
- The premises shall be maintained in a neat and clean condition at all times free of debris, hazardous waste and combustible waste materials.
- Applicants use of the premises, the condition of the premises and the facility shall at all times comply with the Ordinances and Codes of the City of Wood River, Hall County, Nebraska.
- 4. The use permitted herein shall not impede the normal and orderly development of the surrounding property for uses permitted in the District.
- 5. Nothing in this Resolution shall be construed as a grant of right, authority or privilege to permit or allow any use of land that would violate any state or federal law or any rule or regulation of any state or federal administrative agency.

- 6. The acceptance by Applicant of any benefit or right pursuant to this Resolution shall constitute Applicant's agreement to be bound by the terms and conditions and restrictions of this Resolution.
- 7. The rights, privileges and obligations granted by the Resolution shall not be assigned or transferred without the written consent of the City of Wood River, Hall County, Nebraska.
- 8. This conditional use shall expire in 5 years on October 17, 2028.

- 3. That the establishment of the conditional use will not impede the normal and orderly development of the surrounding property for uses permitted in the District.
- 4. That adequate utilities, access roads, drainage and or necessary facilities have been or being provided.
- 5. That adequate measures have been or will be taken to provide ingress and

- egress so designed as to minimize traffic congestion in the public streets.
- 6. The use shall not include noise which is objectionable due to volume Frequency or beat unless muffled or otherwise controlled.
- 7. The use shall not involve any pollution of the air by fly ash, dust, vapors or other substance which is harmful to health, animals, vegetation or other property or which can cause soiling discomfort or irritation.
- 8. The use shall not involve any malodorous gas or matter which is discernable on any adjoining lot or property.
- 9. The use shall not involve any direct or reflected glare which is visible from any adjoining property or from any public street, road or highway.
- 10. The use shall not involve any activity substantially increasing the movement of traffic on public streets unless procedures are instituted to limited traffic hazards and congestion.
- 11. The use shall not involve any activities substantially increasing the burden on any public utilities or facilities unless provisions are made for any necessary adjustments.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT Applicant's application for conditional use of the premises for constructing a permanent 72X40 metal sheeted building with a bathroom prior to building a residential dwelling should be and is hereby granted subject to the conditions, restrictions and limitations contained herein:

- 1. The premises shall be used solely for establishing and operating a gunsmithing business and such other
  - "permitted uses" within the R-6 Medium Density Residential district.
- 2. The premises shall be maintained in a neat and clean condition at all times free of debris, hazardous waste and combustible waste materials.
- Applicants use of the premises, the condition of the premises and the facility shall at all times comply with the Ordinances and Codes of the City of Wood River, Hall County, Nebraska.
- 4. The use permitted herein shall not impede the normal and orderly development of the surrounding property for uses permitted in the District.
- 5. Nothing in this Resolution shall be construed as a grant of right, authority or privilege to permit or allow any use of land that would violate any state or federal law or any rule or regulation of any state or federal

- administrative agency.
- 6. The acceptance by Applicant of any benefit or right pursuant to this Resolution shall constitute Applicant's agreement to be bound by the terms and conditions and restrictions of this Resolution.
- 7. The rights, privileges and obligations granted by the Resolution shall not be assigned or transferred without the written consent of the City of Wood River, Hall County, Nebraska.
- 8. This conditional use shall expire in 2 years on October 17, 2025.
