Official City Council Minutes City of Wood River, Nebraska Regular Meeting October 8, 2024

Pursuant to due call and notice thereof, a Regular Meeting of the City Council of the City of Wood River, Nebraska was conducted in the Council Chambers of City Hall, 108 W. 10th St, on October 8, 2024. Notice of the time and place of the meeting was given in advance thereof by publicized notice on October 2, 2024 in the Clipper and the Grand Island Independent. An agenda for the meeting, was kept continuously current, and was made available for public inspection on the City's website (woodriverne.com).

Mayor Greg Cramer called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Council Present: Rotter, Thompson, Rodriguez, Klingsporn, Rennau, Nielsen.

City Officials Present: Ashley Manning, City Clerk; Christina Wemhoff, City Treasurer

Public Present: Deputy J. Jones; Darren Bartunek; Mady Kenny; Steve Wolford; Michael Carlson; Richard Siefken

The Mayor led the Council Members and audience in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Cramer advised the public body of the Open Meetings Act that is posted in the meeting room and entry hall.

Public Comment(s): None.

Nielsen made the motion to approve items on the consent agenda. Motion seconded by Thompson. Motion carried. 5/0. Rodriguez abstained.

Deputy J. Jones offered a summary of the Sheriff's report for September 2024.

Nielsen motioned into Public Hearing at 7:02pm to hear public comment regarding issuing a Conditional Use Permit to Darren Bartunek on lots located at 308 E. 13th St. authorizing two (2) 5-plexes to be constructed. Motion seconded by Thompson. Darren Bartunek was present to answer any questions. Michael Carlson asked for specifics of the project and expressed concerns about parking, added noise, and rental properties possibly lowering the area values. Bartunek explained that each end unit will have a 2 car garage and the middle units will each have a 1 car garage for parking, all located on a private drive between the 2 5-plexes. He stated that there would be no sidewalks from the units to the City streets. Bartunek plans to provide all lawn and snow removal services to the property. Bartunek invited everyone to look up the work he did in Phillips recently to see how nice his units are. Bartunek plans to rent the units for around \$1,200-\$1,400 per month and utilize Da-Ly Realty out of Grand Island to manage the rentals as they handle all of the background and credit checks for tenants. Richard Siefken asked about street parking and asked that the City put up no parking signs. Council explained that there is an Ordinance in effect that is being enforced regarding the amount of time one can be parked on City streets. As there were no further comments Nielsen motioned to move out of Public Hearing at 7:15pm. Motion seconded by Thompson.

Nielsen motioned to introduce and pass Resolution 2024-205 A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONDITIONAL USE OF REAL ESTATE LOCATED AT 308 E. 13th ST., WOOD RIVER VILLAGE DODD AND MARSHALL'S ADDITION LOTS 1-2-3 BLOCK 1 AND THE WEST 33' OF WALNUT

STREET ABUTTING LOT 1 BLOCK 1 DODD AND MARSHALL'S ADDITION, HALL COUNTY, NEBRASKA. Motion seconded by Thompson. Motion carried 6/0.

Nielsen motioned to introduce Resolution 2024-206 A RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE SALE OF CERTAIN PERSONAL PROPERTY BY SEALED BID SALE AND ESTABLISHING THE MANNER AND TERMS THEREOF. Motion seconded by **Rodriguez**. Motion carried 6/0.

Nielsen introduced Ordinance 589 AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN TERRITORY AS SHOWN ON THE ANEEXATION PLAT PREPARED BY BROWN SURVEYING SERVICES, BRYAN ADAM BROWN, A PROFESSIONAL LAND SURVEYOR, DATED MAY 30, 2024, LOCATED IN SECTION TWENTY-FOUR OF TOWNSHIP TEN NORTH RANGE TWELVE WEST OF THE 6TH P.M., HALL COUNTY, NEBRSAKA. Motion seconded by Rennau. Motion carried 6/0.

Mady Kenny with JEO presented Council with the proposed plans for the Senior Center portion of the Legacy Station, JEO plans to advertise to bid and begin getting permits yet this week, if approved, and have the pre-bid meeting on October 22 at 2:00pm with bids due on November 6 at 2:00pm. Rotter motioned to approve the proposed plans and to begin advertising to bid the project. Motion seconded by Rennau. Motion carried 6/0.

Mayor Cramer asked Council to consider a covenant for the Casey's property to require them to construct a sound barrier wall and maintain a green space. Will bring the covenant draft back to the next meeting with more input from Cramer.

Rennau motioned to approve payment to Bigzbys Concrete (Invoice 4336) in the amount of \$10,932.94 for work completed on Thelen Street in 2021. Motion seconded by Thompson. Motion carried 6/0.

Nielsen motioned to approve Change Order #2 for a deduction of \$1,698.60 from contracted price due to removing seed from project with Van Kirk Bros – 8th St. Water Main project. Motion seconded by Thompson. Motion carried 6/0.

Rotter motioned to approve signing certificate of substantial completion and issuing final payment to VanKirk Bros. Contracting in the amount of \$120,038.00 for the 8th St. Water Main project. Motion seconded by Rennau. Motion carried 6/0.

Rennau motioned to approve payment to Diamond Engineering (Invoice 5084) in the amount of \$42,530.00 for culvert replacement on 130th Rd and Hwy 30. Motion seconded by Rodriguez. Motion carried 6/0.

Rotter motioned to approve payment to JEO (Invoice 154442) in the amount of \$19,650.00 for work completed on the Senior Center Project CDBG # 22-PW-009. Motion seconded by Rennau. Motion carried 6/0.

Thompson motioned to approve draw request #9 in the amount of \$12,271.42 for project CDBG # 22-PW-009. Motion seconded by **Nielsen**. Motion carried 6/0.

There were three bids received for architectural services for the Library/Food Bank portion of the Legacy Station: W Design, JEO, Carlson West Povondra. The Library selection committee met and reviewed the bids received using a scoring sheet. The scores were then averaged and totaled as follows: Carlson West Povondra 84/100; JEO 79/100; W Design 91/100. The committee recommended W Design to award the contract. Rotter motioned to approve awarding the architectural contract to W Design for the Library/Food Pantry portion of the Legacy Station Project. Motion seconded by Nielsen. Motion carried 6/0.

Rennau motioned to approve signing letter of authorization with W Design for the Library/Food Pantry portion of the Legacy Station project. Motion seconded by Rotter. Motion carried 6/0.

Rennau motioned to approve signing letter of authorization with W Design for the Legacy Avenue civil engineering. Motion seconded by Rodriguez. Motion carried 6/0.

Nielsen motioned to approve accepting resignation from Christina Wemhoff with a final work day of October 14, 2024. Motion seconded by Rotter. Motion carried 6/0.

Mayor Cramer asked Council to consider advertising for a Deputy Clerk position rather than a Treasurer. Cramer would like to look into outsourcing some of the budgetary responsibilities previously handled by Christina and having Manning take over the other treasurer tasks. Rotter motioned to approve advertising for a Deputy Clerk position. Motion seconded by Rennau. Motion carried 6/0.

Wolford: (1) Mentioned that Nebraska Rural Water would be able to assist with a rate study. (2) Received permit for street light, will contact Brent to get it ordered. (3) Would like to put the Babel's water/sewer project out to bid next month.

Council Remarks:

Nielsen: (1) Marty has been working with the State to get the nitrogen levels down at the sewer plant. Wolford explained that Marty has been measuring the sludge in the tanks and managing accordingly. Sewer plant does need new doors and windows. (2) Would like to look into electronic time keeping system to track hours worked for employees.

Mayor's Remarks:

- 1) The bio plastics company that was considering coming to Wood River decided to go with a location in Indiana but will possibly reconsider in 5 years.
- 2) Tallgrass-Carbon Capture has requested temporary power, that project seems to be moving forward.

As there was no further business to come before this session of the Council, Council member Nielsen made the motion to adjourn at 8:14 p.m. Motion seconded by Rodriguez.

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN TERRITORY AS SHOWN ON THE ANNEXATION PLAT PREPARED BY BROWN SURVEYING SERVICES, BRYAN ADAM BROWN, A PROFESSIONAL LAND SURVEYOR, DATED MAY 30, 2024, LOCATED IN SECTION TWENTY-FOUR OF TOWNSHIP TEN NORTH RANGE TWELVE WEST OF THE 6TH P.M., HALL COUNTY, NEBRASKA. SAID ANNEXATION IS PURSUANT TO NEB. REV. STAT. §18-3301 AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO FILE A MAP OF THE ANNEXED TERRITORY AND PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the owner of the property located in the Northeast Quarter of Section Twenty-Four, Township Ten North, Range Twelve West as shown on the Annexation Plat as Lot 1 prepared by Brown Surveying Services, Bryan Adam Brown, a professional land surveyor dated May 30, 2024 filed with the City and the Regional Planning Commission an application for annexation of said property; and

WHEREAS, the Regional Planning Commission on August 7, 2024 held a public hearing and made a recommendation on the proposed annexation of such area; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing before the City Council was held on September 17, 2024 it appears that the annexation of such territory is deemed necessary for the welfare of the residents and property owners of the territory and the City as a whole.

NOW THEREFORE be it ordained by the Mayor and the Council of the City of Wood River, Hall County, Nebraska.

Section One

By this Ordinance there is annexed to the City of Wood River, Hall County, Nebraska and incorporated within the corporate boundaries of the City the following territory adjoining the present corporate boundaries of the City, all of the property as shown as Lot 1 on the Annexation Plat, prepared by Brown Surveying Services, Bryan Adam Brown, a professional land surveyor dated May 30, 2024 more particularly described as follows:

A TRACT OF LAND CONSISTING OF ALL OF LOT 1 BABEL ACRES SUBDIVISION, HALL COUNTY NEBRASKA, ALL OF LOT 5 RIVERINE SUBDIVISION, HALL COUNTY NEBRASKA AND PART OF THE NORTHEAST QUARTER (NE1/4) OF SECTION TWENTY-FOUR (24),

TOWNSHIP TEN (10) NORTH, RANGE TWELVE (12) WEST OF THE 6TH P.M., HALL COUNTY, NEBRASKA, AND MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:




PROPOSED SUBDIVISION AERIAL MAP
